

## HEALTH AND SAFETY

The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the official stewards. If you come to the event on your own, please notify the organisers on arrival.

## RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Events and competitions are unaffiliated unless stated otherwise. However, they will be run in accordance with the appropriate discipline rule books and in addition the rules set out below.
2. The organisers and landowners accept no responsibility for any loss or damage to any person, animal, vehicle or property whatsoever – however caused. Owners/riders enter entirely at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the organisers, judges or landowner of the show in any respect whatsoever.
3. Cheques should be made payable to **BDRC**.
4. Correct riding attire must be worn – it is the rider's responsibility to ensure this rule is observed.
5. Correctly fitting headgear and boots with heels must be worn by anyone mounted on the showground. Headgear must conform to the current BHS safety standards and must be either PAS 015 or BSEN 1384 standard or be prefixed with AST or SEI and must have a three point harness. Spot checks may be carried out. Non compliance will result in elimination. This rule takes precedent over rules on headgear/footwear contained in any Rules of Affiliated bodies.
6. Back protectors are recommended for show jumping and compulsory for cross country.
7. The judge's and/or organiser's decision is final
8. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without giving a reason and will return the entry fee accompanying such entry.
9. The judges reserve the right to eliminate any unfit or unsound horse/pony. Any person, in the opinion of an event official, seen ill treating a horse/pony will be required to leave the showground immediately and partake in no further competitions at that event regardless of any entry fee being paid.
10. Entry fees will only be refunded on the production of a medical or veterinary certificate.
11. Horse/Ponies are not to be left unattended when tied up to trailers or lorries in the car park.
12. Children must be properly supervised at all times.
13. Please do not leave any rubbish, droppings etc. on the showground.
14. Failure to ring for times (when this is a requirement of the entry) will constitute a withdrawal.
15. If dogs are permitted on the showground, they must be kept on a lead.
16. Local Hunter (class 13) to be living within 10 miles as the crow flies of the showground.

**11.10 - 5 – LEAD REIN – PONIES not exceeding 12.2hh.** To be shown in a snaffle bridle with lead rein attached to noseband. Handlers to be suitably attired.

**11.35 - 6 – HORSE/PONY MOST SUITED TO RIDER - Ridden**

**12.00 - 7 – MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND – Ridden or In Hand** (may be split between small & large breeds if sufficient entries)

**1.00 - 8 – VETERAN – 15 years & Over - Ridden or In Hand**

**1.25 - 9 – COLOURED & ODD COLOURED – Ridden or In Hand**

**1.50 - 10 – NOVICE SHOW HORSE/PONY** (not to have won an OPEN showing class or more than £10 in prize money) - **Ridden or In Hand**

**2.15 - 11 – BEST YOUNG HORSE or PONY for 4, 5, & 6 yr Olds.** To be judged on overall performance – **Ridden or In Hand**

**2.40 - 12 – RIDING CLUB HORSE/PONY CLUB PONY – To be shown in a snaffle bridle. May be required to jump a small fence.** Special rosette for Highest Placed BDRC Member. - **Ridden**

**3.05 - 13 – HUNTER/ COB – exceeding 14.2hh – Ridden or In Hand**

**3.30 - 14 - EX-RACEHORSE – Ridden or In Hand**

**3.45 – 15 – RIDING HORSE – exceeding 14.2hh – Ridden or In Hand**
